David Daniels is a nationally recognized artist and master teacher. He is an accomplished watercolorist who displays a remarkable range of experimentation with the medium and a unique personal sense of composition and color. David earned a Masters of Arts Degree from Central Michigan University and teaches painting at Montgomery College, the Smithsonian Institution and privately in his Silver Spring studio, as well as workshops internationally. David's interactive approach and humor are often recognized as his strongest teaching tools. The heart of the artist and the spirit of the medium are the two most important components of his teaching. Students to focus their attention on why they are painting as much as what they are painting. Students are introduced to methods of using multiple glazes over wet into wet passages to achieve an unsurpassed brilliance as well as the use of masking agents to achieve a jewel-like batik effect.
