Details for drop off locations, receiving, show standards, and opening reception dates for the Spring Show will be in future emails and newsletters.

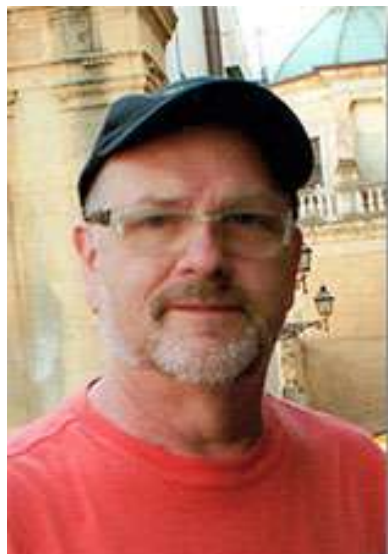
DUES REMINDER

David Daniels is a nationally recognized artist and master teacher. He is an accomplished watercolorist who displays a remarkable range of experimentation with the medium and a unique personal sense of composition and color. David earned a Masters Arts Degree from Central Michigan University and teaches painting Montgomery College, the Smithsonian Institution and privately in his Silver Spring studio, as well as workshops internationally. David's interactive approach and humor are often recognized as his strongest teaching tools. The heart of the artist and the spirit of the medium are the two most important components of his teaching.

Students to focus their attention on why they are painting as much as what they are painting. Students are introduced to methods of using multiple glazes over wet into wet passages to achieve an unsurpassed brilliance as well as the use of masking agents to achieve a jewel-like batik effect.

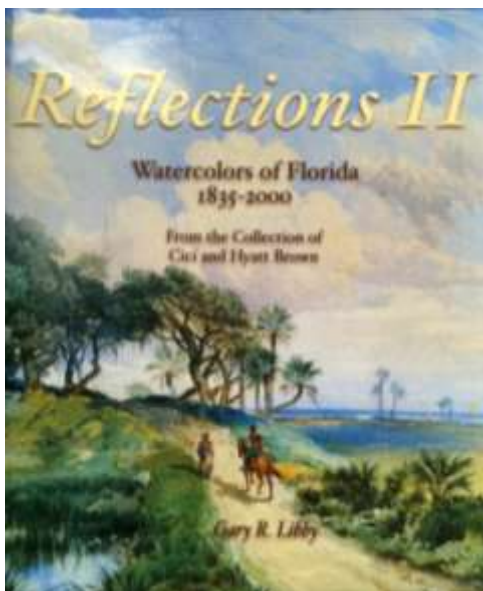

Hercel's painting "River Friends" is included in a new book by Gary R. Libby, former Director of The Museum of Arts and Science in Daytona Beach, Florida. The 358 page coffee table book entitled, Reflections II Watercolors of Florida 1835-2000 is filled with over 140 watercolorists such as Winslow Homer, Thomas Moran, Fujio Yoshida, Ed Whitney, Betty Lou Schlemm, Fred Messersmith, Emmett John Fritz to name a few.
